12. The Queen will conduct herself respectfully at ALL times and in ALL ways as she is representing the county for the year. People are always watching. She will be required to relinquish her title if convicted of a crime during her reign.
13. The pageant director and fair board reserve the right to recall the queen's title at their discretion if any of the guidelines are not followed. If the queen can not carry out her duties during the year and has to relinquish her title, the first runner up will take over any duties/appearances for the remainder of the year.
